


CRBM is looking for a director



The Centre of Research in cellular Biology of Montpellier (CRBM, https://www.crbm.cnrs.fr) is a laboratory under the supervision of the CNRS and the University of Montpellier, internationally recognized in the field of biochemistry and cell biology. Its research focuses on elucidating the molecular mechanisms controlling cell division, adhesion and signaling, morphogenesis, and the role of post-translational modifications in the functions and fate of intracellular proteins. The CRBM is a dynamic and attractive laboratory with a staff of 160, divided into 18 international research teams, 1 R&D team and a start-up.

The CRBM benefits from an exceptional scientific and technological environment, thanks to the UMS Biocampus, which provides access to 18 Montpellier's technological platforms (proteomics, genomics, mouse animal facility, etc.). The CRBM hosts three Biocampus platforms: the MRI Montpellier Ressource Imaging platform, the MGC Montpellier Genomic Collections platform and the ZEFIX Zebrafish and Xenopus Plateform, which can be found on the website (https://www.biocampus.cnrs.fr).

The CRBM is a member of the Pole Biology & Health of the University, which brings together Montpellier's 1,500 researchers, the Montpellier SIRIC, LabMuse "Epigenemed", and the recently awarded I-SITE MUSE. The CRBM is located on the CNRS "route de Mende" site, which brings together 4 INSB research units with a total staff of 450 (CEPIMAI, IGMM, IRIM & CRBM, which are organized into a Federation), the INC's Balard Chemistry Center with a staff of around 700, and the INEE's Centre d'Ecologie Fonctionnelle et Evolutive (CEFE).

The CRBM Director will define the unit's strategy, policy and scientific leadership. He/she will be responsible for the institute's budget, and will decide on the use of funds in consultation with the supervisory authorities. The Director will also define and organize the future PI recruitment policy, including preparing calls for junior and senior PIs. At the same time, the Director will pursue his or her research and teaching activities.

This mission will take effect on January 1, 2027, for a period of 5 years, renewable once. Candidates for the position of director of the CRBM must hold a position in a research organization (CNRS or INSERM), or at the University of Montpellier, or possibly at another French university, subject to secondment. Applications, including CV, covering letter and summary of research activity, should be sent to Claude Prigent, director of the CRBM, by June 1st, 2024.
